

Oh Let Us Come and Worship the Lord (Part 6)
The Proper Worship
(2 Cor. 3:18)

Introduction: I read the story of a little boy who got on the plane and very excitedly asked, “Are they really going to let me meet the pilot?” There was an observation made in that moment by the story teller. “No one else’s face shone with such excitement.”

In fact, with few exceptions everyone else seemed to be just content. The thought occurred to me, “Were the people on the plane any different from some of the people sitting in the pews these days?” People in the pews seem to be content with coming in sitting down, enjoying the assembly with no surprises and no turbulence. (Nice is all they want), and nice is what they are going to get. Few come in with that childlike enthusiasm that wants MORE!

I want to tell you today, as we wrap up this sermon series, that if we want more out of our worship experience, there is more to be had. And proper worship is the way to get it.

- C. Would this new and different view of the Lord change my face?** (Ex. 34, Acts 6 & 7)

III. What if our worship affected others?

I promise you the excitement of the boy on the plane had others wanting to see the pilot and cockpit too!

- A. If we want more from our worship, we can get it!**

C. Do you think others are watching to see how we worship?

IV. What if our worship caused us to want to do more with the Lord?

- A. What if we worshiped in way that made us hungry to serve the Lord?**
- B. What if the sparks of our worship could light a fire in others?**
- C. What if we took our approach to worship from Jesus, to prepare properly:**
