GATE OPERATION

We frequently receive calls about the operation of the front gate. We are finding that some residents have accidentally blocked the gate number as it wasn't a phone number you recognized. The Tanglewood Gate phone number is 863-402-1098. If you have blocked this number, you will want to go in and unblock it. It is suggested you create a contact in your phone for this number and call it "Gate".

When you have someone coming to your home, they will pull up to the front gate and dial your four digit house number followed by the round call button. If your house number is only 3 digits they will add a 0 in front of it. This will ring the phone you gave us to put in the gate system. You will answer your phone and make sure whoever is at the gate is someone you wish to let in. You will then press and hold the number 9 on your phone for a few seconds. This will allow access to the person at the gate.

This process works even when you're not at your home. Many residents have lawn services, cleaning companies, etc. that come to your home in your absence. You will want to be sure the phone number you gave us is a cell phone so you can receive calls from the gate wherever you are. You are responsible for letting them through the gate. We can't allow them access if they call the office. It is easy for anyone to pull up to the gate and call the office and tell us they are the lawn company for you and you aren't answering and expect us to let them in. If you have any questions about the gate operation, please give the office a call and we will be happy to assist.

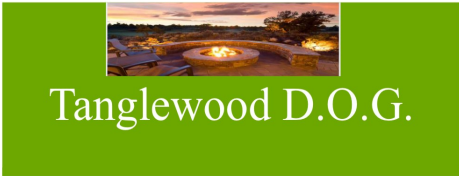

Wed. October 9 the Big Red Bus will return to the front of the Clubhouse from 9-3.

The call is urgent but now seriously urgent for Tanglewood as one of our residents is in need of a transfusion. Turned down a few months ago as the blood supply was dangerously low and the resident did not meet the criteria required. Now things have gotten worse and the need is even greater..

Each donation can save as many as 3 lives, yours may save the life of a Tanglewood resident.

Each donor will receive a health check which includes: pulse, temp., blood pressure, O2, iron count and cholesterol screening. Also a \$20 eGift certificate and a free gift.
