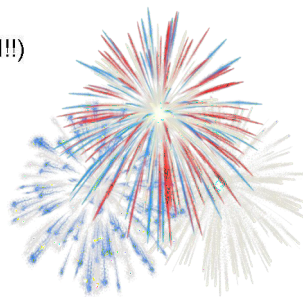

If you've never been to a TMAC Pot Luck, this is the time to start. With lower numbers attending everyone is fed in ten minutes."

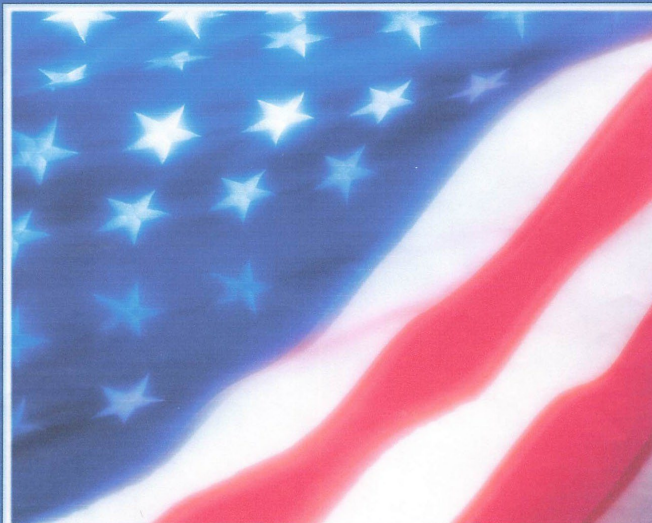

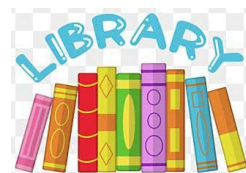
